

INVITATION EU-UKRAINE DEFENCE INDUSTRY FORUM

On behalf of the European External Action Service, the European Commission, the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine, and the Ministry for Strategic Industries of Ukraine:

We have the pleasure to invite you to the 2nd EU-Ukraine Defence Industry Forum (DFNC2) on:

Monday, May 12th, 2025, from 9.00 to 18.30 at The SQUARE Brussels Meeting Centre, Mont des Arts, 1000 Brussels

The Forum is co-organised by the European External Action Service, the European Commission and the Ukrainian government. The organisation is supported by the Polish Presidency of the Council of the European Union, the European Defence Agency, and the Aerospace, Security and Defence Industries Association of Europe (ASD). The first edition of the Forum on 6 May 2024 demonstrated its value as a platform for dialogue between the EU and Ukrainian authorities and industries.

The White Paper for European Defence - Readiness 2030, presented by the Commission and High Representative on 19 March 2025, called for enhanced military support to Ukraine, associating Ukraine into EU-level activities for the common development and procurement of defence capabilities, and integration of the Ukrainian defence industry into the European Defence Technological and Industrial Base (EDTIB).

In this context, the second EU-Ukraine Defence Industry Forum (DFNC2), will be a timely opportunity to take stock of the progress and plans in terms of providing military assistance, and identify further avenues for EU-Ukraine industrial cooperation, with the aim of integrating the Ukrainian defence industry into the EDTIB.

The Forum will consist of two sessions:

- During the **High-Level Conference** in the morning, keynote speakers and panellists will outline Ukrainian defence priorities, the latest developments in terms of military assistance to Ukraine and support to its defence industry, as well as the ambitions from the White Paper. Industry panels will particularly allow to take stock of progress in cooperation activities between EU and Ukrainian defence industries, and draw lessons from companies' experience in joint ventures, including challenges and bottlenecks. Defence industry representatives will have the possibility to share views on how policy-makers at the EU level, in Member States, Ukraine and Norway can best incentivise cooperation among defence industries, including across sectors.
- In the afternoon, a Companies' Matchmaking Event will provide opportunities for EU based, Norwegian and Ukrainian aerospace, security and defence companies to engage on industry segments and capabilities identified by Ukraine, with the support of the B2match platform for advance booking of meetings. The afternoon session will also provide an opportunity for a number of stakeholders from both the EU and Ukraine to present their activities in support of defence industrial cooperation through display materials.

Representatives of governments and industry of EU Member States, Norway and Ukraine are invited to take part in the Forum.

Attendance to the Forum is in-person only and limited to two representatives per company.

Participation is limited to 200 industry representatives from entities based in the EU and in Norway. Invitations to Ukrainian entities will be circulated by the Ukrainian government via a separate communication channel.

To ensure a balance between European and Ukrainian companies, a fair geographical representation among European companies, and taking into account the defence industrial needs identified by the Ukrainian government, the organisers will confirm participation to registered participants.
